Forty metres, ten cabins, and a jacuzzi with a view.

Nevra Queen is a 40-metre gulet designed for large groups who want to travel together without compromise. Ten cabins — two masters, six doubles, and two twins — accommodate up to twenty guests, each with en-suite bathrooms and air conditioning. That's the kind of capacity that makes multi-family holidays or milestone celebrations feel easy rather than logistically complex.

On deck, a jacuzzi sits forward with an uninterrupted view of wherever you happen to be. The aft dining area seats everyone at once, and the flybridge offers a second living space for the afternoons when part of the group wants to read while the others are in the water. A 115 HP tender, jet ski, water ski, ringos, kayaks, and SUPs keep things moving.

A crew of seven manages the boat, the meals, and the route — leaving twenty people with nothing to organise except when to jump in. Twin 600 HP engines and a 9-metre beam give her the stability and range to cover ground when the itinerary demands it.

Forty metres of gulet — ten cabins, twenty guests, and enough deck space to never feel crowded.

The saloon — built for twenty, finished in warm timber, and connected directly to the aft deck.

LAYOUT

How the space works.

Nevra Queen's 9-metre beam gives her the space to arrange ten cabins without feeling tight. The two masters sit aft with the most room and natural light, six doubles run along the midship corridor, and two twins are positioned forward. All cabins have en-suite bathrooms. The saloon connects to the aft dining area, the flybridge provides a second social space, and the foredeck jacuzzi sits far enough forward to feel private.

2 MASTER CABINS

Aft-positioned masters with double beds, en-suite bathrooms, air conditioning, and the widest footprint aboard. Natural light from portholes and overhead hatches.

6 DOUBLE CABINS

Midship doubles with double beds and en-suite bathrooms. Individual climate control and consistent finish throughout — each cabin is fully self-contained.

2 TWIN CABINS

Forward twins with two single beds each, en-suite bathrooms, and the same standard of finish. Ideal for friends, siblings, or older children.
